A Word from Our Priest

My sisters and brothers,

I bring you greetings in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and * of the Holy Spirit.

On March 2, we will celebrate the Transfiguration of Our Lord. On this day we will gather the palms from last year to be burned and then used for the imposition of ashes on Ash Wednesday, March 5th this year. This marks the beginning of the Lenten season, a preparatory penitential time in the church year. The imposition of ashes with the Holy Eucharist will take place at Grace 11:00AM and St. Luke's at 7:00PM.

Lent is forty days not including Sundays, as Sundays are a celebration of Our Lord's Resurrection. During these forty days a practice of prayer, fasting and alms-giving is at the forefront. This is also a time for preparation for Baptism or reaffirming one's Baptism. In the early church Baptism only occurred once a year and that was at the Easter Vigil. We refrain from festival activities like weddings until Lent and Holy Week are complete. There are acceptable exceptions to this practice like an unexpected deployment to a hostile theater.

Lent is associated with self-penitence including the practice of self-denial, i.e. what I am going to give up for Lent? Some say strong drink (15-year-old single malt scotch) and chocolate head the list of items to give up. I say consider what you will continue after Lent. As soon as Lent is over, the chocolate is back. Could this be a time to start a new discipline such as morning and evening prayer that would continue to be practiced after Lent?

The color for Lent is purple to represent the royal sovereignty of Our Lord. The crosses are veiled suggesting what if this gift of grace had not been given. The Hymn of Praise and Alleluias or Hallelujahs are absent during the Lenten season. Deep reflection is strongly encouraged.

May we embrace this season of reflection and renewal with open hearts and steadfast spirits. Let us journey together, supporting one another with love and grace, as we deepen our relationship with God and prepare ourselves for the joyous celebration of Easter.

Income in the month of January was \$5,606.71 (budget \$9,709.92); expenditures totaled \$8,009.93 (budget \$9,709.92), resulting in a loss for the month of \$2,403.22.

Book value of the Endowment Fund at the end of January was \$73,059.87; market value as of January 31 was \$81,913.52, a gain of \$1,671.12 for the month.
